Losing appetite

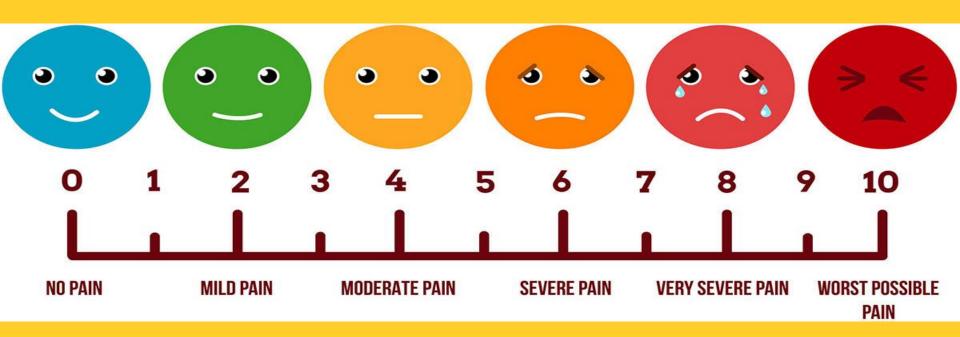
Rest or sleep disorder

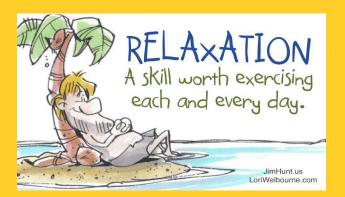
#### With Medicine

#### **Without Medicine**

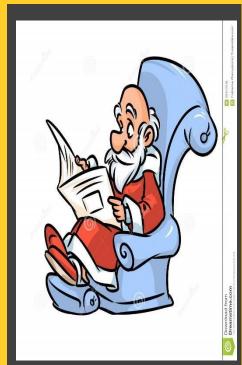
- 1. Information

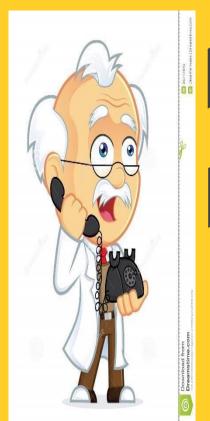

#### **Unbearable pain**

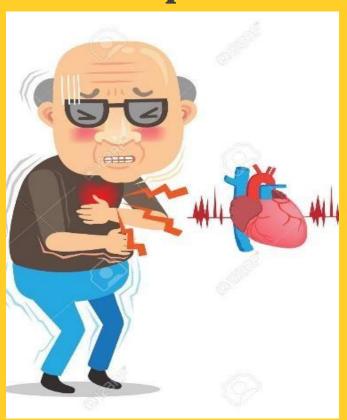


**Unchanging pain after treatment** 



Having side effect: itchy, constipation, nausea, stomach pain, difficult breathing, easily feel sleepy, bleeding, others

## Chest pain because of Heart Attack



#### Could be detected with:

- Left chest pain (feel pressed or pushed)
- Pain widened to jaw, neck and back
- Shortness of breath
- Tiredness, fatigue
- Cold sweat
- Nausea, gastritis
- Migraine or headache
- Pain will relieve when resting
